- This luminaire has a built-in power supply; just connect the luminaire to a 220-230VAC electrical supply to make it work.

- This type of luminaire can be larger and heavier than a luminaire with a remote power supply.
- The terminal block is not included; installation may require the advice of a qualified person.
- Luminaire designed for direct installation on normally flammable surfaces.
- Do not look at the luminaire in normal use for more than 10 seconds as this can be dangerous for the eyes.
- This product meets all the essential requirements of each of the directives applicable to it.
- The luminaire should be positioned in such a way that prolonged viewing of the luminaire at a distance of less than 0.20 m is not possible.
