### Wiring instructions for units equipped with EMERGENCY function:

Emergency lighting luminaire must be installed and maintained in accordance with the emergency lighting standard BS 5266-1

- For the emergency unit to work correctly, please ensure that an uninterrupted permanent live feed is
  present and is connected directly to the 'Permanent Live' terminal of the mains terminal block. Please
  ensure there are no switches, PIRs etc within the permanent live feed, constant switching of the
  emergency pack could result in premature battery failure.
- Following power up the green LED indicator should illuminate to indicate charging. If power to the unit is
  disrupted or isolated, the unit indicating green LED will switch off, triggering the emergency LEDs to
  illuminate.
- When self-test mode is selected, 24hrs from connection to mains power, a 3hrs duration test will be performed automatically.

### **Installation Procedure:**

- 1. Connect mains cable to the Loch3 Connector as per image.
- 2. If the driver has been disconnected, re- connect using Jack Connector.
- 3. Choose CCT setting required, located on supply cable to panel
- 4. Fit the panel into the desired location.
- 5. Reconnect the mains supply.
