Cill/Floor Mount Spindle - PS.260

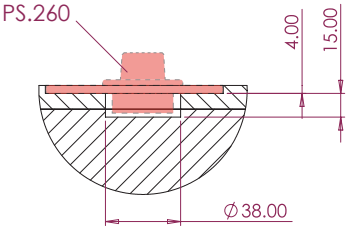

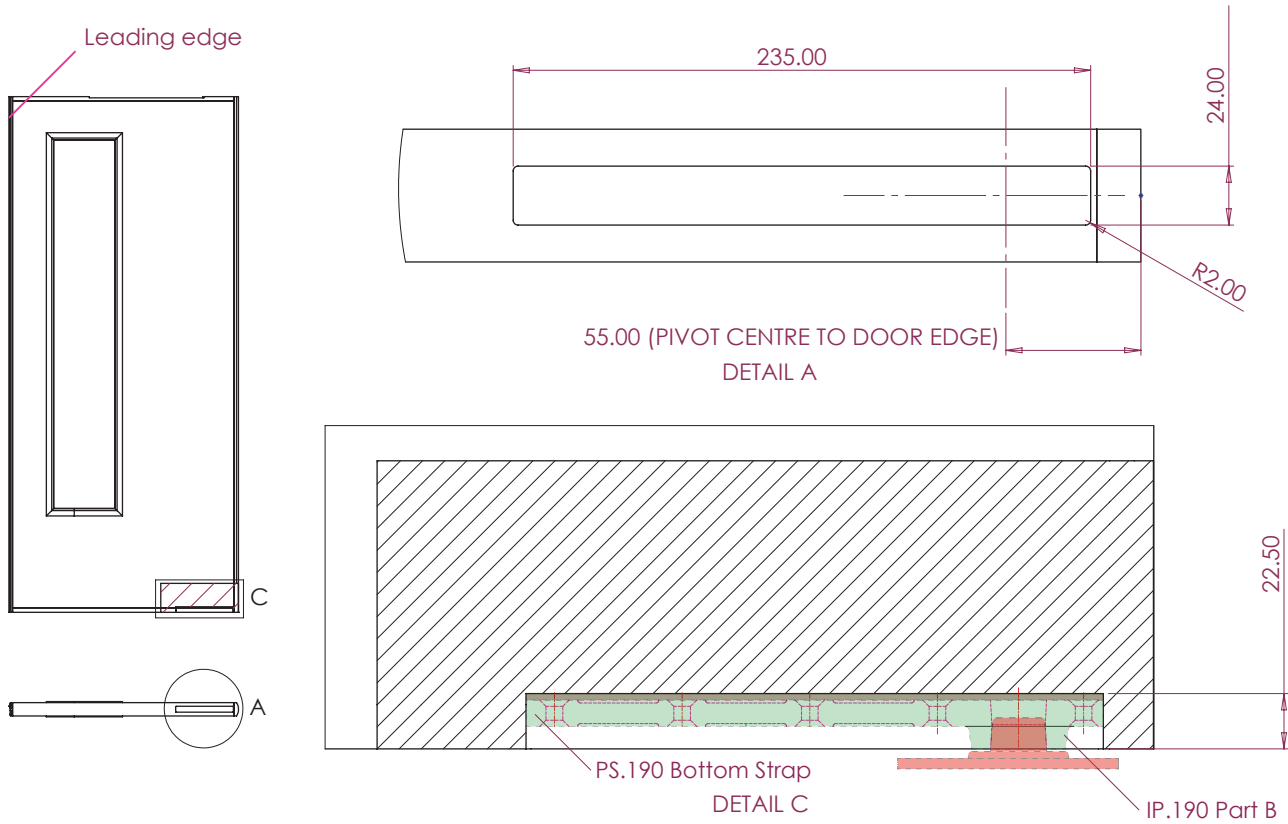

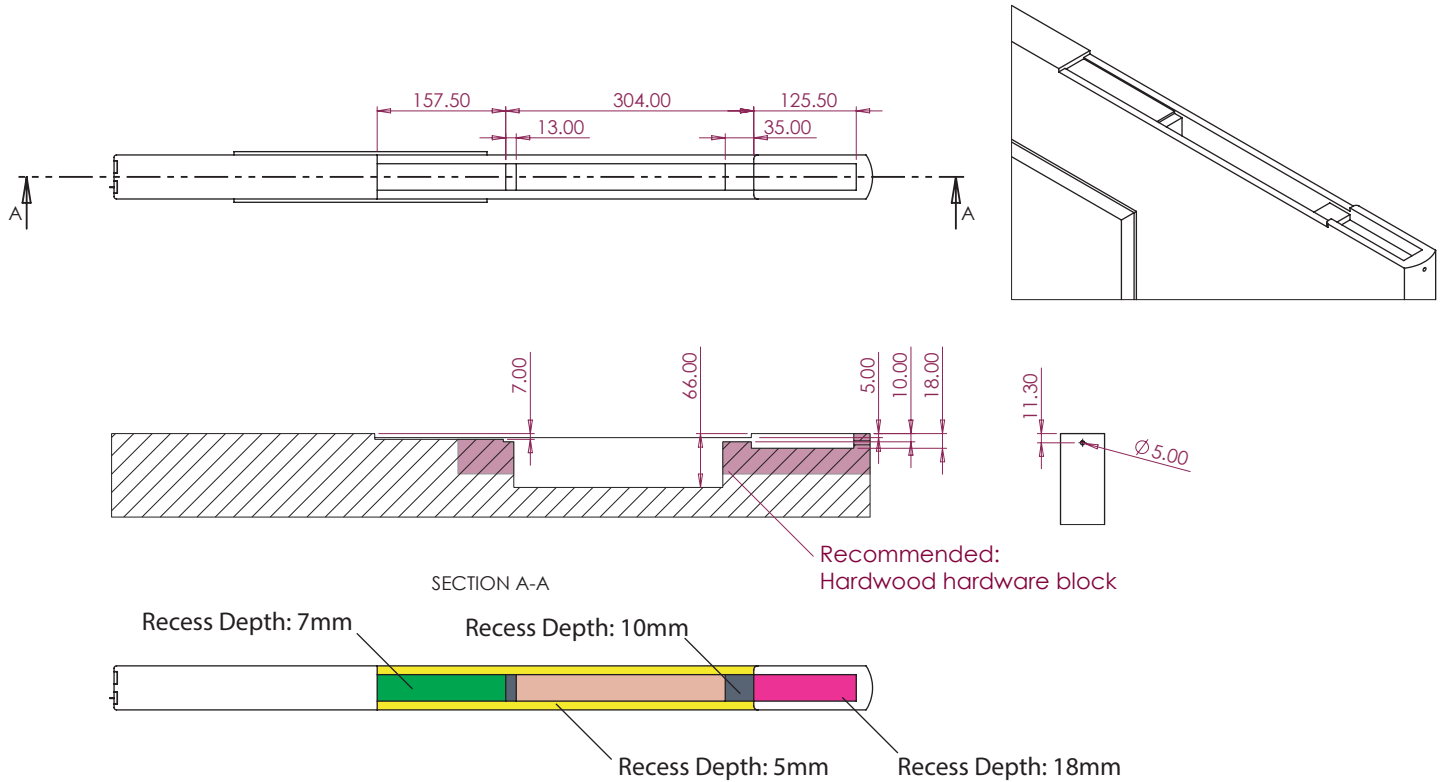

Door Leaf (bottom)/Bottom Pivot - PS.190 Bottom Strap



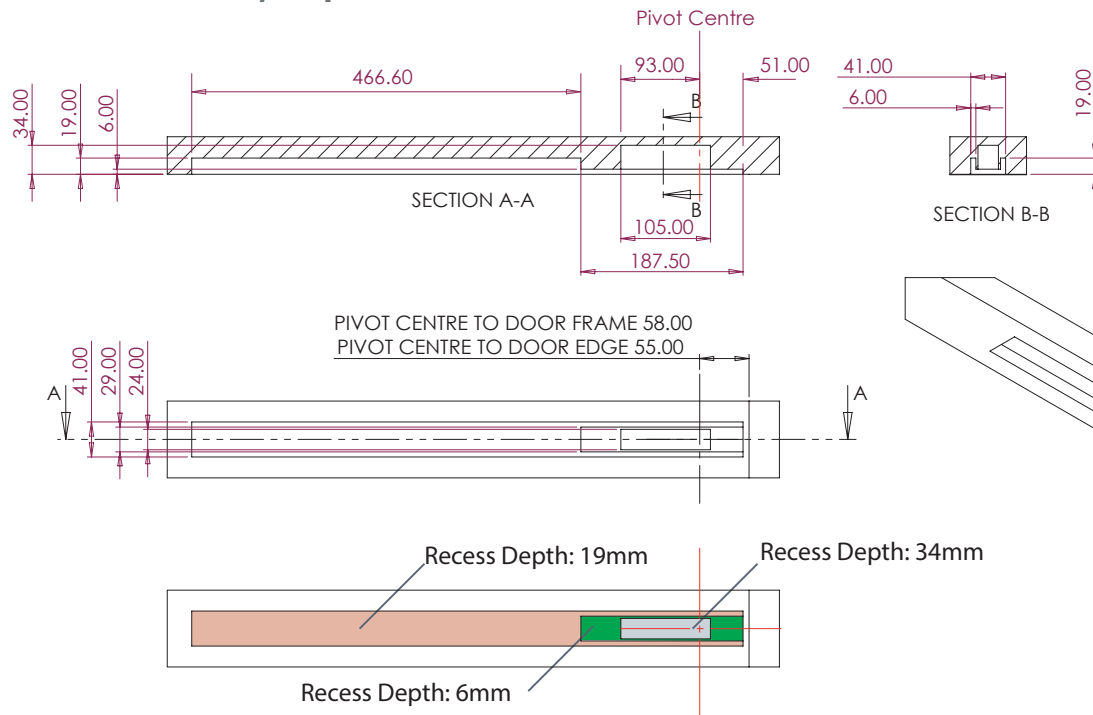

Door Leaf (top)/Top Pivot Strap - PS.190 Top Plate & ITS.11204 Door Closer



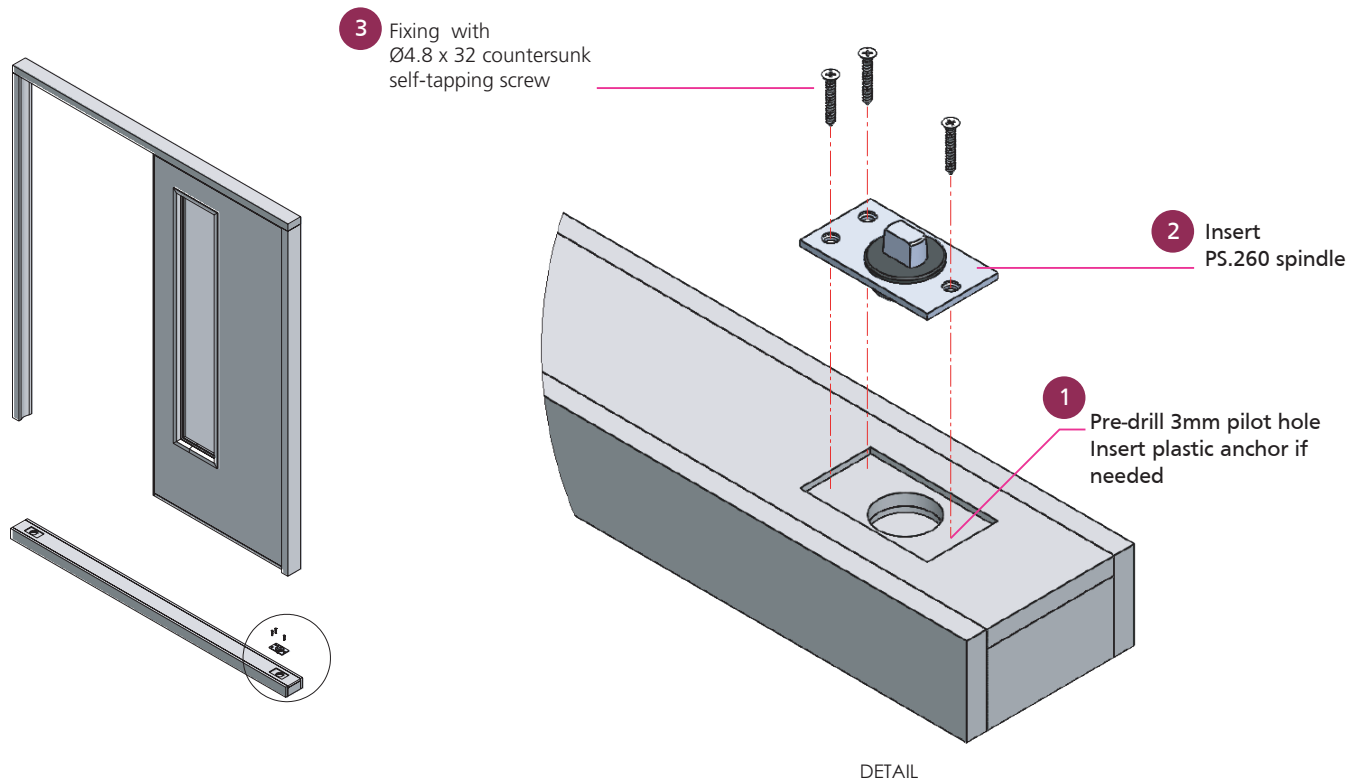

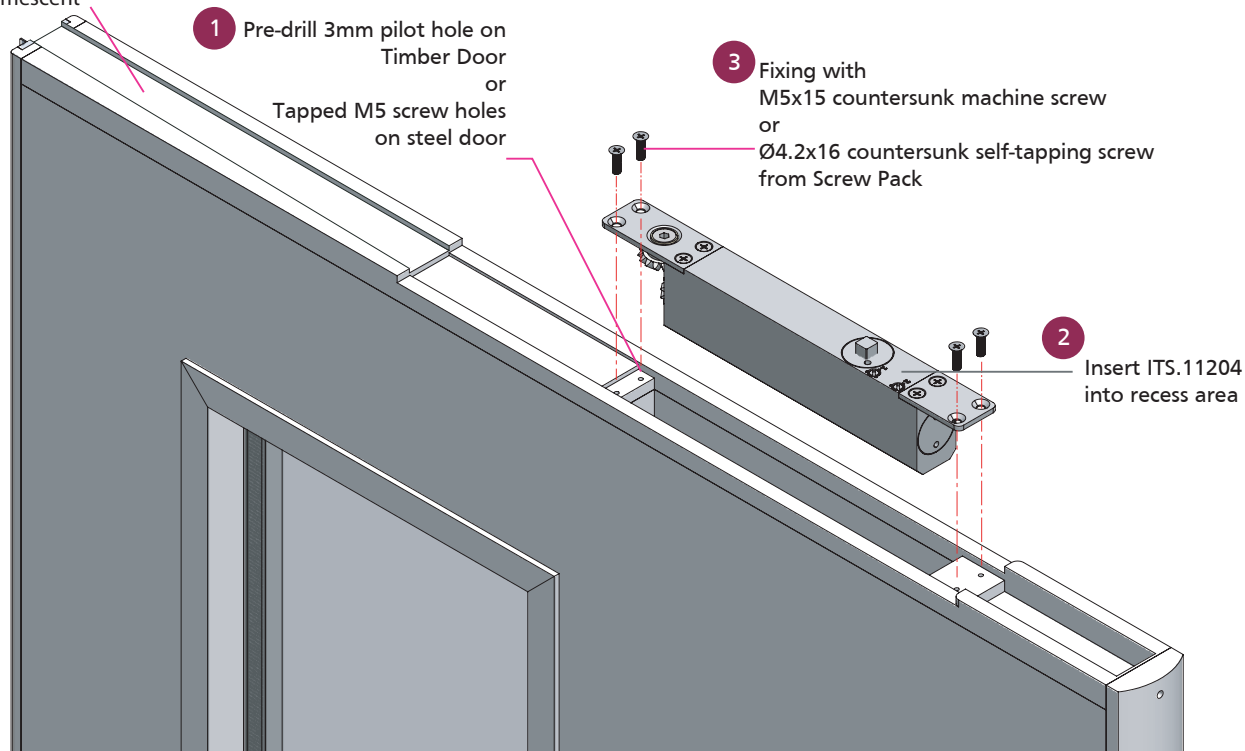

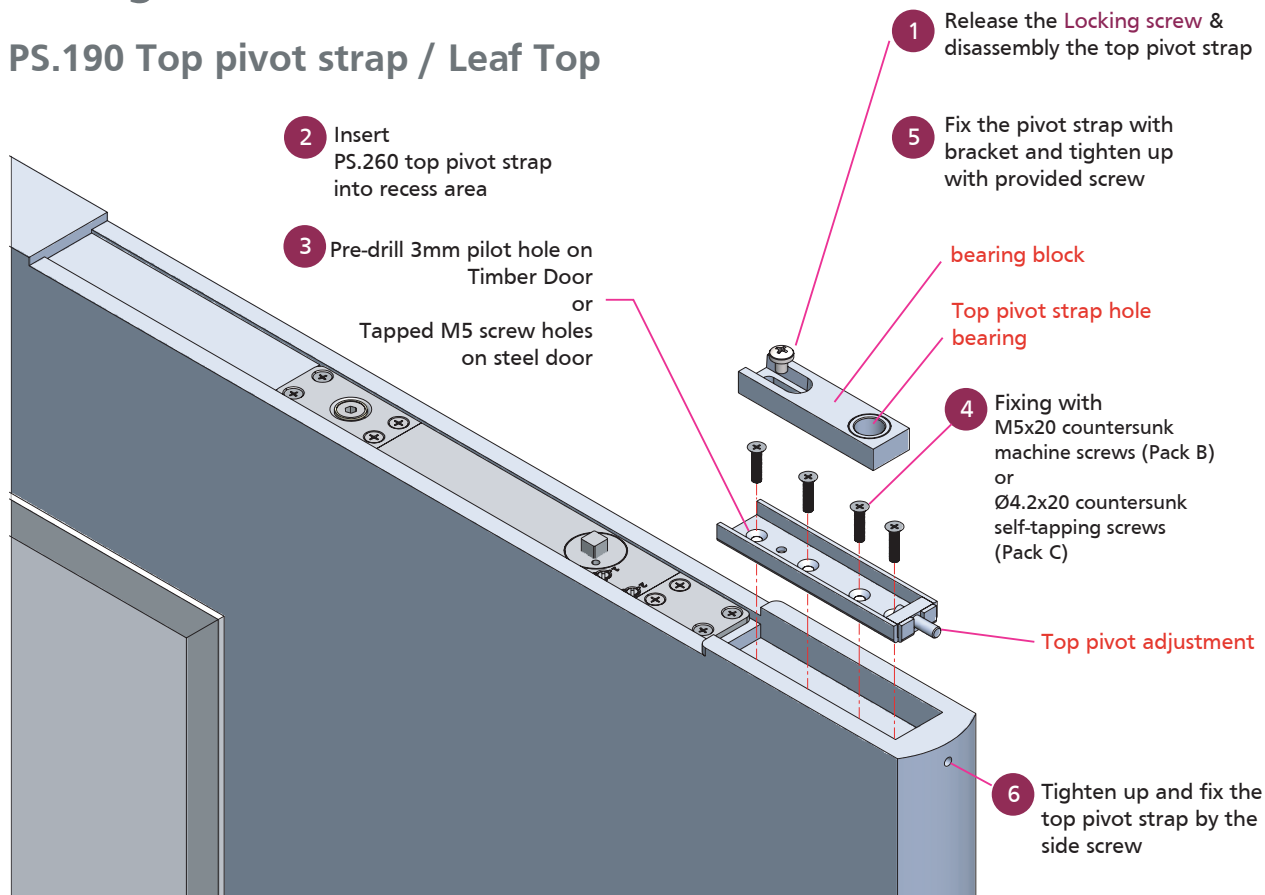

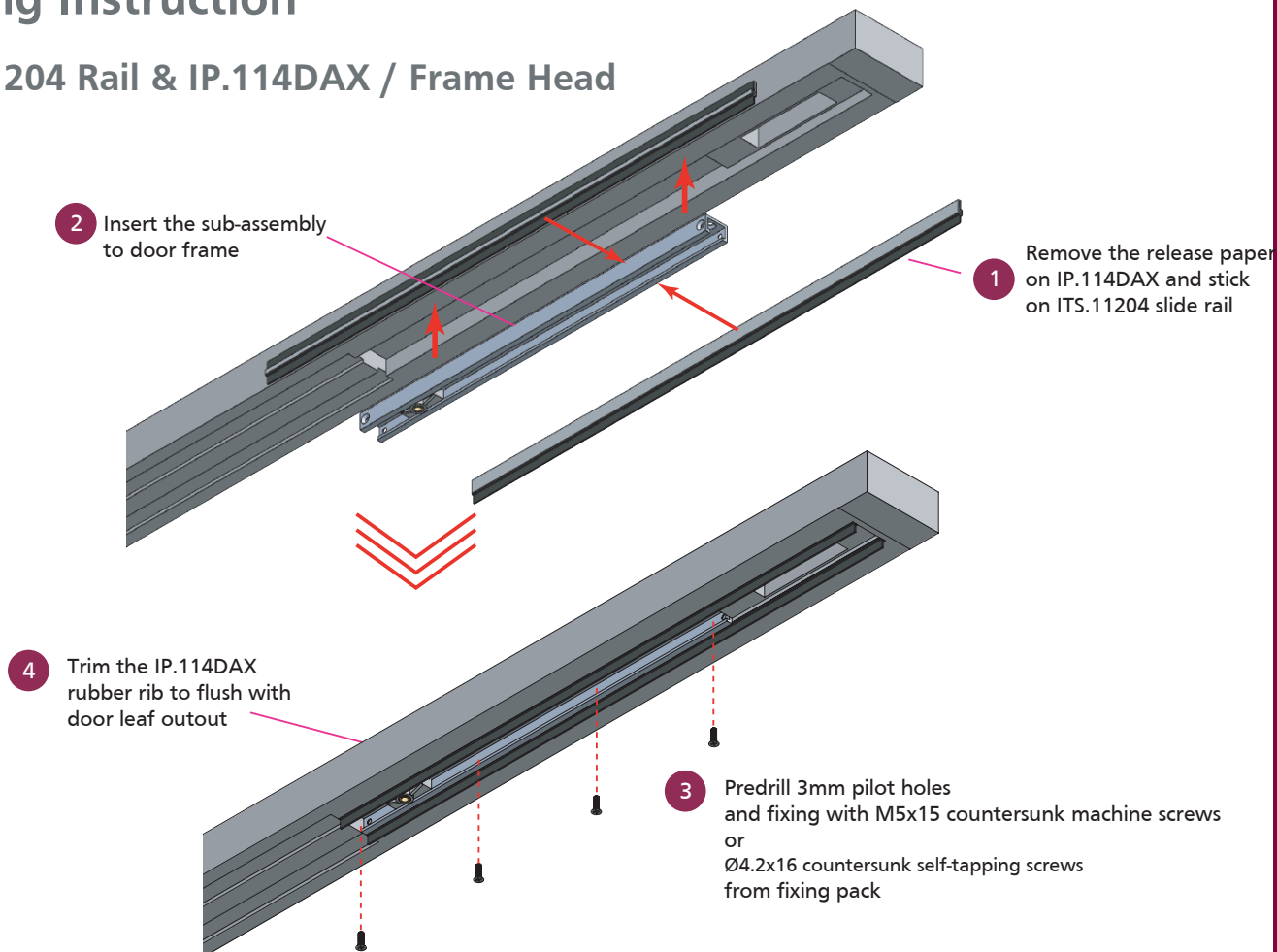

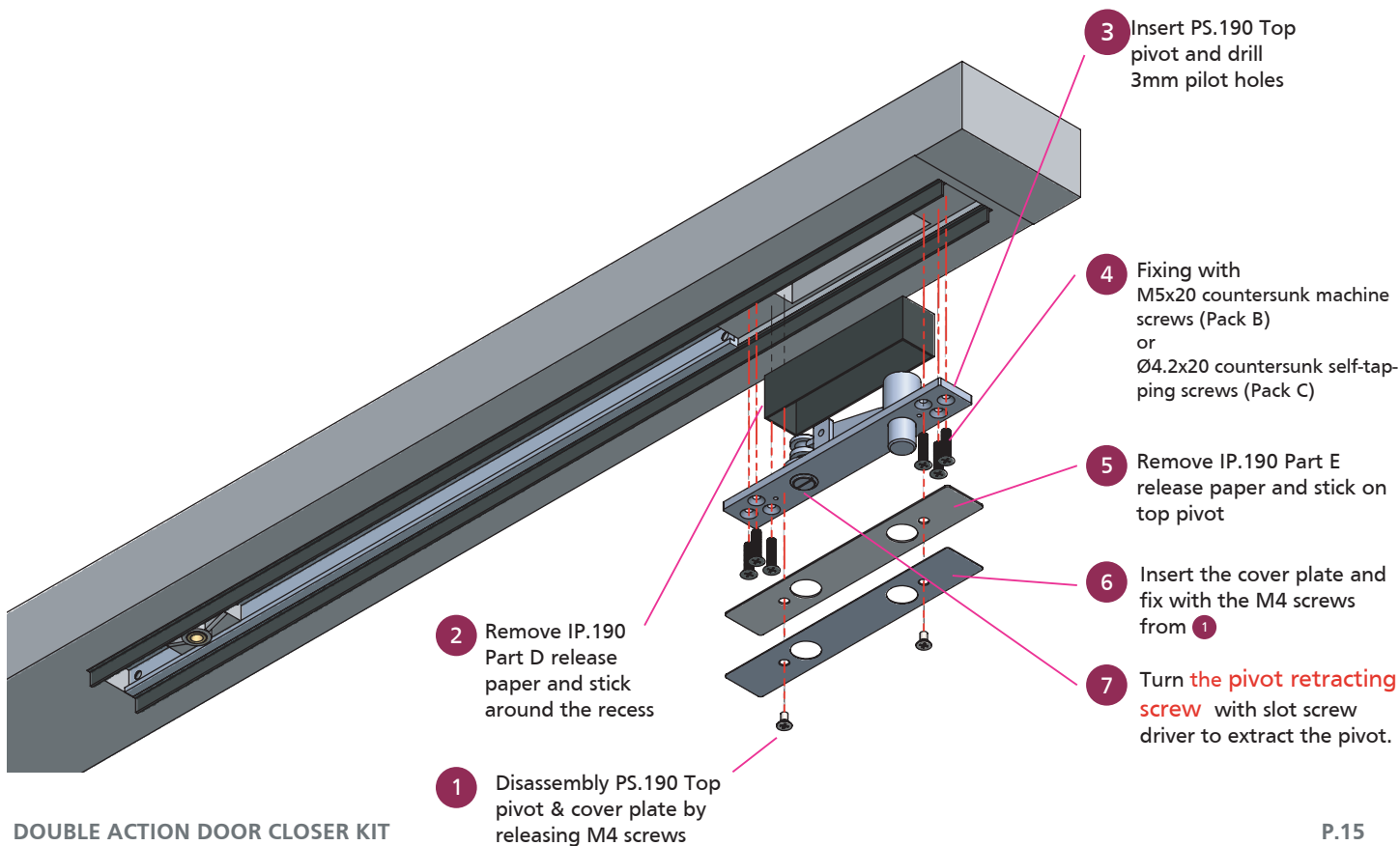

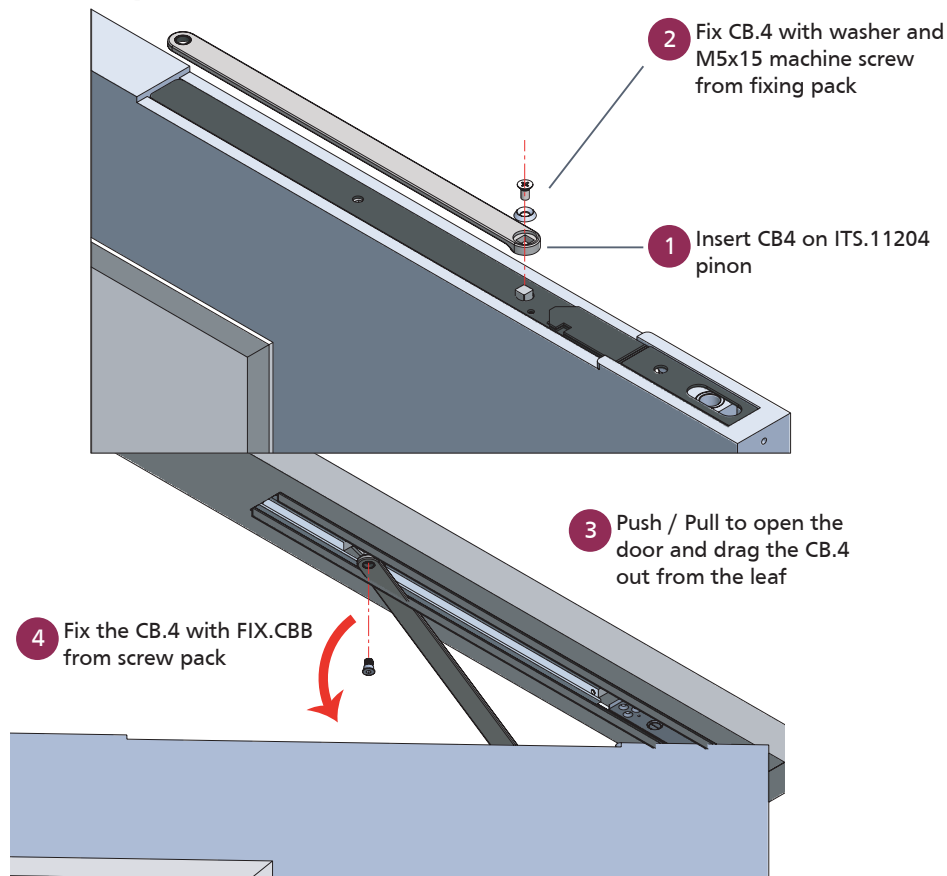

Fitting Instruction - Door Alignment

1. Fit PS.190 Top Pivot into Top Pivot Strap in head of door leaf
2. Slacken off the **Top Pivot Strap locking screw (P. 13)** screw
3. Now carefully lift the door leaf at 90 degrees to frame and locate bottom strap onto the PS.260 Floor Mount Spindle
4. Now offer up the door, still at 90 degrees to the frame, to meet head frame
5. The top Pivot Strap in the head of the leaf is now aligned with the retractable pivot in the head frame
6. With the door leaf at 90 degrees to frame will allow you access to the frame mounted **top pivot adjuster (P. 13)**.
7. Using a screw driver turn **the pivot retracting screw (P. 15)** until the retractable pin is fully engaged into **the top strap hole bearing (P.13)**.
8. Now set position of meeting stiles by tightening the **Top Pivot Strap locking screw (P. 13)** in the hinge edge of the door – this locks the strap into position and keeps the door level so you can achieve correct gaps at the frame and at meeting edge if double doors.
9. Now open the door to 90 degrees
10. Now fully retract the top pivot again
11. Lower the door to access the top pivot strap
12. Push the **bearing block** to lock against the **top pivot adjuster (P. 13)**
13. Now tighten **Top Pivot Strap locking screw (P. 13)**
14. Now offer the door back into position
15. Engage the retractable pin fully into **the top strap hole bearing (P.13)**

KEY & CAUTION

- A. Fit for purpose fixings – each floor type is different from concrete to timber and therefore professional independent advice should be taken from fixing suppliers to consider the building type, users, structural material, weights and all other considerations.
- B. Finger trapping caveat - recommend reviewing and adding a finger guard protection to final install

Valve & Power Adjustment



Before adjusting any valves ensure the door and frame are fixed firmly and the door will close easily into the frame and latch.

- To increase the speed of a door turn the valve 1 (No.5) Anti-clockwise. If door closing too fast turn the valve 1 Clockwise to reduce the speed to a satisfactory movement.
- When the door is latching too fast adjust the valve 2 (No. 6) to the desired satisfactory action. Turn Clockwise to reduce the speed.
- If the latch is getting stuck, turn Valve 2 anti-clockwise to increase the speed but not too fast so that it slams.
- If more power is needed to overcome the latch or Intumescent seal you can increase the power by turning the power adjustment function (No. 7) with an allen key.
- If the door is too easy to open or affected by wind or air pressure, turn Clockwise to increase the power.
- If the door is stiff to open you can turn Anti-clockwise to decrease the power.

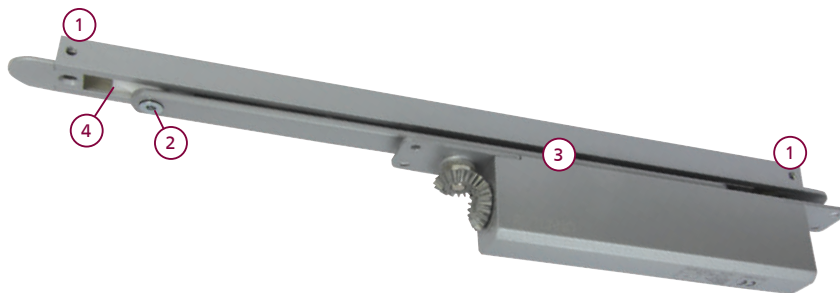

6 ways to trouble shoot a Door Closer

Maintenance

**Step 1**

Check that screws are tight (No.1 & No.2), and tighten if needed, at least every 6 months.

Step 2

Tighten pinion screw (No. 3) to 12nm, at least every 6 months

Step 3

Lubricate all moving parts, except the sliding shuttle (No.4) , at least every 6 months.

*For high usage closers, this steps will need to be carried out more often than every 6 months.

Any unusual sounds or visual defects should be addressed immediately
